

Instructions for Civilians to Obtain A Base Pass for McMurry Courses at Dyess AFB

As noted in the course schedule book, civilian students are welcome to take classes at our Dyess AFB campus site as space permits. While on Base please keep in mind that we are guests and all rules and speed limits must be observed.

PLEASE NOTE THAT TALKING ON YOUR CELL PHONE WHILE DRIVING IS NOT PERMITTED UNLESS YOU HAVE A HAND FREE DEVICE.

As a reminder, your vehicle may be searched at any time. No firearms or illegal substances are permitted. *You cannot obtain a base pass until the day your class begins*

1. On arrival at the Base, park in Visitor's Parking Lot (to right of Main Gate) and enter building to obtain pass. **You must have a current driver's license, and proof of vehicle insurance.** We may request your birth date, driver's license number, and state prior to your first visit.
2. The Base issues a two-part paper pass noting the day and times which you may enter the Base. (It is authorized by the McMurry-Dyess office.) One portion is kept on your person and the other must be displayed on the left front dashboard. Upon entering the Main Gate, drive slowly so that the pass can be seen, and you will be admitted through the gate post by the 7th Security Forces. Have your driver's license and pass available for viewing.
3. Classes are held approximately two miles inside the Base, at the Education Center building, 425 3rd Street. Entrance is on the north side of the building, mid-section. Classrooms are posted on the second floor landing bulletin board and are held throughout the three story building. A policy regarding food and beverages is read in class. No smoking is permitted in the building, near the outside exit doors, or outside stairs. Also, no other tobacco products of any kind are permitted.

Directions

The Base is located off of Hartford Avenue and Arnold Blvd. The Visitor's Center is located to the right of the Main Gate. Once pass is obtained, return to the Main Gate for approved entry. Drive approximately 2 miles before reaching the circle flag. Stay in the outside lane of the circle and take the second right (the Chapel will be on the right), which is Avenue B. Continue on Avenue B to 3rd Avenue. Make a left at 3rd Avenue. Approximately one quarter mile on left there are three, three story buildings with a parking lot in front. Education Center is the building to the far right, 425 3rd Avenue, Building No. 7232.
