

# EARLY CHILDHOOD ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## CISCO JUNIOR COLLEGE / McMURRY UNIVERSITY

- The following courses at Cisco Junior College will meet requirements for the major in Early Childhood Education at McMurry University.
- Please refer to the list of general education transfer equivalent courses for those that will meet the general education requirements at McMurry.
- Courses accepted for transfer to McMurry must have a grade of "C" or higher.
- Courses completed at CJC are not used to meet the advanced hour requirement at McMurry.
- Admission to the Teacher Education Program at McMurry requires an overall G.P.A. of 2.75 or higher and the following results on the THEA:  
MATH Score of 230 or exemption status based on grade in Math course; WRITING Score of 240 or exemption status based on grade in English course;  
READING Score of 250 (exemption not applicable).
